

DIGEX STANDARDIZES E-MAIL HOSTING SERVICES ON ROCKLIFFE MAILSITE

BELTSVILLE, Md.—APRIL 29, 1999— Digex, Incorporated, a leading provider of Web hosting and application hosting solutions for businesses, today announced an agreement with Rockliffe Systems, Inc., an emerging developer of Internet-based e-mail server software for enterprise solutions.

The agreement states that Digex will deliver Rockliffe MailSite Enterprise as its standard e-mail package for Windows NT customers.

Also, as part of the agreement, Digex and Rockliffe have agreed to work closely at an engineering level to ensure that Digex's customers receive optimal e-mail hosting services. Further, Rockliffe has extended to Digex product and support incentives in exchange for the volume of software licenses Digex has agreed to purchase within the agreement.

"Faced with a shortage of skilled IT professionals, more and more businesses are asking Digex to host e-mail services. Rockliffe delivers the level of reliability, scalability and speed that our customers seeking Windows NT-based e-mail hosting services demand."

Digex has already deployed more than 50 licensed copies of MailSite at its nationwide data centers. "Of all the Internet-based e-mail server software we evaluated on Windows NT, Rockliffe MailSite is the only one that delivers rock-solid reliability, extreme scalability, and speed in a single package," said Steve Keifer, manager of marketing and product development for Digex.

"Rockliffe is excited to enter this strategic relationship with Digex in its growth plans," said John Davies, president of Rockliffe. "By combining Digex's expert knowledge and experience of Windows NT with the reliability of Rockliffe MailSite, Digex delivers robust e-mail hosting solutions to its customers."
