

MAILSITE SERVES EMAIL, CALENDAR AND CONTACTS TO OUTLOOK 2007 WITHOUT PLUG-INS

NEW LOW-COST ALTERNATIVE TO MICROSOFT EXCHANGE IS NOW AVAILABLE

Campbell, CA – July 30, 2007 – MailSite Collaborator 8, the leading low-cost alternative to Microsoft Exchange, is now available. This new release is a major upgrade to MailSite and for the first time includes a calendar and contact server in addition to a robust and proven email server. MailSite Collaborator 8 provides most of the functionality of Microsoft Exchange but costs approximately 20% of its price.

MailSite Collaborator 8 has been designed to work extremely well with Microsoft Outlook 2007. Not only does MailSite provide an excellent email server for Outlook 2007, but now calendars and contacts can be synchronized as well. This functionality is provided natively in MailSite and does not require any plug-ins for Outlook.

MailSite Collaborator 8 is also compatible with other calendar clients such as Apple Mac iCal, Google Calendar, Microsoft Windows Vista Calendar and Mozilla Sunbird. This makes it easy for MailSite users to share their calendar with co-workers inside the business as well as friends, family and colleagues outside the company. Full calendar details or just free-busy information can be shared this way. This makes it possible to truly collaborate for the first time with people in your intranet **and** your extranet.

MailSite Collaborator 8 includes a new web client called MailSite ExpressPro that has been developed from the ground up using the latest AJAX web technology. The look and feel of MailSite ExpressPro is very similar to Microsoft Outlook. Users who are familiar with Microsoft Outlook will be immediately comfortable with MailSite ExpressPro. MailSite ExpressPro works with all major web browsers including Apple Safari 3, Mozilla Firefox 2 and Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 and 7.

MailSite was voted as one of the top three email servers by readers of Windows IT Pro Magazine in September of 2006. With its long and successful track record as an email server, MailSite naturally works very well with all email clients including Microsoft Outlook, Outlook Express, Microsoft Windows Vista Mail, Apple Mac Mail, Mozilla Thunderbird and Qualcomm Eudora.
