Rockliffe adds content filtering for e-mail server

New MailSite 4.5 filters spam, viruses and porn before they enter a users system and enables UK service providers to conform to new RIP bill

Internet messaging solutions developer Rockliffe has announced the immediate availability of a spam, virus and porn filtering tool in the latest release of MailSite, its scalable messaging platform. New MailSite 4.5 enables service providers to conform to the new UK RIP regulations and filter viruses, spam (unsolicited mail), and porn. It also adds end user language choices for web-based e-mail, and wireless access to e-mail.

This new version of MailSite uses a standard Internet filtering language called Sieve. Sieve allows administrators to create powerful filters that will block spam, viruses and porn before they enter the system. This reduces the load on the messaging server and eliminates the need for third party filtering software. The MailSite Sieve Filter is bundled with MailSite 4.5 at no extra cost.

"We believe that we are one of the first companies to ship this new Sieve capability. We have built our Sieve Filter to integrate seamlessly into MailSite and it complements our existing anti-spam and secure relay features. With MailSite 4.5 UK service providers can be confident of meeting the requirements of the RIP bill," said Rockliffe European director Alun Davies.

MailSite Pocket offers end users wireless access to e-mail

MailSite Pocket means that e-mail providers hosting with MailSite 4.5 can offer end users the ability to check email on the move through any WAP-compliant device such as mobile phones and PDAs. Rockliffe expects MailSite Pocket to particularly appeal to UK and European markets where WAP is more developed than in the USA.
